## The story behind “Be Thou My Vision”

In 373 AD a young man was born along the banks of the River Clyde in what is now called Scotland. He is the only missionary to be honoured with a global holiday. He is also the only one known by his distinctive colour green. We are of course talking about that great missionary to Ireland St Patrick. Patrick’s back ground was a religious one with his great grandfather being a deacon and his father a priest.

Pirates raided his town when he was about 16 and even though he hid in the bushes he was spotted and taken prisoner and taken to Ireland as a slave. It was in Ireland that he gave his life to the Lord. Later on he would write “The Lord opened my mind to an awareness of unbelief, in order that I might remember my transgressions and turn with all my heart to the Lord my God.”

Patrick eventually escaped and went back to his home where his family welcomed him with open arms and begged him to never leave again. Nevertheless, one night in a dream, Patrick saw an Irishman begging with him to return and evangelise Ireland.

This wasn’t an easy decision for Patrick, however he did return to Ireland and his former captives. He took with him one book, the Latin bible. Huge gatherings came to hear him, although the superstitious Druids opposed him and tried to have him killed.



However, Patricks preaching was powerful and he became one of the most successful evangelists of all time. He planted around 200 churches and baptised around 100,000 converts.

Patricks work continued, and several centuries later, the Irish church was still producing hymns, prayers, sermons etc. Sometime in the eighth century a poet, unknown, wrote a prayer asking God to be his Vision, wisdom, and his best thought by day and by night.

Mary Elizabeth Byrne, a scholar in Dublin, translated this poem into English in 1905 while another, scholar, Eleanor Hull of Manchester England took this translation and gave it verses with rhyme and meter. Soon after it was set to the Irish folk song "Slane". This is an area in Ireland, where, the story has it, Patrick challenged the Druids with the gospel.

It is one of our oldest and most moving hymns

Be Thou my vision, O Lord of my heart  
Naught be all else to me save that Thou art.  
Thou be my best thought by day or by night,  
Waking or sleeping, Thy presence my Light
