The story behind Rock of Ages

Augustus Montague Toplady was born in Farnham England on the 4th November 1740. His father was killed in a war and his mother spoiled him rotten. He was disliked by most of his relatives, while his friends thought him neurotic and sickly.

One thing Augustus did have however, was an interest in the Lord. On his eleventh birthday he penned these words: "I am now arrived at the age of eleven years, I praise God I can remember no dreadful crime; to the Lord be the glory. He was eager to share his interest in God and by the age of twelve was preaching sermons to whoever would stop and listen. His hymn writing began at the age of 14.

While attending a service in a barn at the age of 16 he converted to Christ and at the age of 22 he was ordained an Anglican priest.

Augustus was a staunch Calvinist and, as such, utterly despised John Wesley's Arminian theology and soundly attacked him with these words: "I believe him to be the most rancorous hater of the gospel-system that ever appeared on this Island." Another time he said, "Wesley is guilty of satanic shamelessness of acting the ignoble part of a lurking, shy assassin".

In 1776, Augustus wrote an article about God's forgiveness intending it to be a slap in Wesley's face. At the end of his article he penned these words from one of his original poems. PTO



Let the water and the blood,
From Thy wounded side which flowed,

Save from wrath and make me pure.

Augustus wasn't very old when he died, only 38. His poem has certainly outlived him and it has been called "the best known, best loved and most widely useful" hymn in the English language.

However, Wesley had written something similar 30 years before. In the preface of a book hymns of the Lord's supper Wesley wrote: "O Rock of Salvation, Rock struck and cleft for me, let those two Streams of Blood and Water which gushed from the side, bring down Pardon and Holiness into my soul.

Maybe these two were not so incompatible as they thought they were.
