The Story Behind “Stand up, stand up for Jesus”

After serving his father as assistant at Philadelphia's church of the Epiphany for many years, Dudley Tyng was finally elected as its pastor upon his fathers retirement.

At first he seemed to fit right in, however, that soon soured as he began to preach against slavery quite vigorously. After a number of complaints against him, he resigned in 1856. He and his followers set up another church in another part of the town and he began to hold midday bible studies at YMCA. His ministry reached far and wide.

He felt that one of his responsibilities was to lead fathers and husbands to Christ. This resulted in him organising a rally and on March 30 1858 five thousand men turned up to hear him preach. At this rally he said “I would rather this right arm were amputated at the trunk than that I should come short of my duty to you in delivering God’s message”¹ It has been reported that over 1,000 men were converted that day.

However, tragedy was to strike Dudley two weeks later. While visiting a farm he was watching a corn thrasher at work. He moved a little to close and the right sleeve of his coat was caught in the thrasher resulting in Dudley’s right arm being torn from its socket.

The main artery was severed and four days later his right arm was amputated.

On his deathbed Dudley said to his aged father "Stand up for Jesus, father, and tell my brethren of the ministry to stand up for Jesus"2

The Rev George Duffield, having been stirred by Dudley's funeral, preached from Ephesians 6 the following Sunday about standing firm for Christ. He also read a poem that he had written. This poem was inspired by Dudley's words:

Stand up, stand up for Jesus, Ye soldiers of the cross Lift high His royal banner; it must not suffer loss

After hearing this poem, an editor of a hymnal found appropriate music and published it. This hymn soon became a favourite hymn around the world thereby extending Dudley's dying words to millions.
