How Great thou Art

In 1885, Carl Boberg²⁶ at the time, wrote a poem that he titled "O Store Gud- O Mighty God. It was translated several times, first into German and then into Russian. Stuart Hine, and English missionary, later translated it into English: The words literally translated said:

*When I the world consider, Which thou has made by
thy almighty Word*

And how the webb of life thou wisdom guideth

And all creation feedeth at Thy board

*Then doth my soul burst forth in song of praise Oh, great God, oh,
great God*

Hine also added two of his own original verses to the poem.

Carl Boberg got his inspiration for this song as he walked home from church one day. As he was walking along he was listening to the Church bells when a sudden storm got his attention. It was reported that: "a thundercloud appeared on the horizon, and soon lightning flashed across the sky. Strong winds swept over the meadows and billowing fields of grain. The thunder pealed in loud claps. Then rain came in cool fresh showers. In a little while the storm was over, and a rainbow appeared.

When Boberg arrived home, he opened the window and saw the bay of Mönsterås like a mirror before him... From the woods on the other side of the bay, he heard the song of a thrush... the church bells were tolling in the quiet evening. It was this series of sights, sounds, and experiences that inspired the writing of the song.

How great thou art was popularised as the “signature song” of the 1950s Billy Graham Crusades. It was popularised by George Beverly Shea and Cliff Barrows during Billy Graham crusades.

As the story goes, when the Billy Graham team went to London in 1954 for the Haringay Crusade, they were given a pamphlet containing Hine's work. "At first they ignored it, but fortunately not for long," said [Bud] Boberg. They worked closely with Hine to prepare the song for use in their campaigns. They sang it in the 1955 Toronto campaign, but it didn't really catch on until they took it to Madison Square Garden in 1957. According to Cliff Barrows (Dr. Graham's long time associate), they sang it one hundred times during that campaign because the people wouldn't let them stop."

How Great thou Art was voted the United Kingdom's favourite hymn by BBC's *Songs of Praise*. "How Great Thou Art" was ranked second (after "Amazing Grace") on a list of the favourite hymns of all time in a survey by *Christianity Today* magazine in 2001.
