The story behind Jesus Shall Reign

Jesus shall Reign came about through Isaac Watts devoting himself to adapting the Book of Psalms for Christian worship. This work was published in 1719 under the title “The psalms of David Imitated in the Language of the New Testament” Most of the Psalms have been paraphrased with New Testament truths being added and they have been framed into singing form.

Watts explained his approach like this. “Where the Psalmist describes religion by the fear of God , I have often joined faith and love to it. Where he speaks of the pardon of sin through the mercies of God, I have added the merits of a Savior, . Where he talks of sacrificing goats or bullocks, I rather choose to mention the sacrifice of Christ, the Lamb of God. Where he promises abundance of wealth, honor, and long life, I have changed some of these typical blessings for grace, glory and life eternal, which are brought to light by the gospel and promised in the New Testament.”¹

A number of these have become firm favourites and have stood the test of time. For Example, Watts’s rendition of Jesus Shall Reign has been called the first mission hymn.

Jesus shall Reign also played a role in the life of the Scottish Olympic hero of the 1924 Paris Olympic games, Eric Liddell.

Liddell became a missionary to China with the London Missionary Society. His departure for China was quite a memorable occasion. He was escorted to Waverley Station from the Scottish Congregation Church in a brightly decorated carriage. A huge crowd had gathered at the station to see him off. Before Eric boarded the train he told the crowd that he was going abroad to try and do his best in unifying the countries of the world under Christ. He said "Let our motto be 'Christ for the world, for the World Needs Christ.'"² He then led them in two verses of Jesus shall Reign.

It would appear that had Eric sung all the verses he would have come to this one (a verse I don't ever remember singing). The saints shall flourish in His days, Dressed in the robes of joy and praise; Peace, like a river, from His throne Shall flow to nations yet unknown
