BIBLICAL APPROACH TOWARDS NATURE

There is a misconception that human being is the crown of God's Creation. The first Creation story ends on the seventh day when God takes rest. In Genesis 2:2, "And on the seventh day, God finished the work that he had done, and he rested on the seventh day from all the work that he had done." God's rest and hallowing on the seventh day, known as Sabbath, is the crown of Creation. The earth also has the right to rest on the sabbath.

In Leviticus 25:4, "but in the seventh year there shall be a sabbath of complete rest for the land, a sabbath for the Lord: you shall not sow your field or prune your vineyard."
